Introduction


The Banner Processional is a time of celebration of the Weekend of Pilgrimage and the connectionalism of the United Methodist Church. Groups are asked to create a banner, based on the guidelines below.

General Guidelines


- 1. The banner must have the group's name on it.
- 2. The banner must be able to be handled comfortably by one person.
- 3. No taller than 9 feet.
- 4. No wider than 4 feet.
- 5. The banner must be made of PVC supports.
- 6. The banner must be created by the youth of the group with adult guidance. The banner should not be made by adults only.

Special Notes

The height, width and banner support points are criitcal to the success of the banner processional. Due to the limited space beside the stage (the area that the banners move through), the Ministry Team has strategically determined the dimensions of the banner.



A PVC connection of this sort is recommended:



Be sure to add a loop of fabric (in addition to the 9 feet) to connect the banner to the PVC support poles.
